Dr. Quinton T. Ross, Jr., serves with distinction as the 15th President of his alma mater, Alabama State University. Dr. Ross assumed the helm of the University with a vision of growth and innovation and has been the driving force behind new initiatives and partnerships under his guiding mantra of “Moving ASU 150 years forward.” Under President Ross’s leadership, the University has experienced a number of significant achievements, including earning reaffirmation of accreditation by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC), with no recommendations, through 2030.

Recently, President Ross was appointed to the Board of Advisors of the White House Initiative on Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) by President Joe Biden. He also has been appointed to the HBCU Financing Advisory Board by U.S. Secretary of Education, Dr. Miguel A. Cardona.

Dr. Ross is a three-time graduate of Alabama State University, where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Political Science, a Master of Education degree in Secondary Education English, and a Doctorate of Education in Educational Leadership, Policy and Law.
